QUALIFICATIONS IN SCHOOLING AND WORKING RACEHORSES



1ST4SPORT LEVEL 3 AWARD IN SCHOOLING RACEHORSES

This qualification is for you if you already have considerable experience of riding racehorses. You may already be employed in the racing industry and wish to progress to schooling racehorses over hurdles and fences and/or through starting stalls. You should be at least 16 years of age, and have an interest and experience in this area.

It will confirm your:

- ability to school racehorses over hurdles and fences, or through starting stalls
- knowledge and skills of confidently riding and schooling racehorses to improve performance
- ability to communicate effectively with trainers to report on horses' performance in relation to fitness, soundness, education and schooling requirements.



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1ST4SPORT LEVEL 3 AWARD IN WORK RACEHORSES TO IMPROVE PERFORMANCE

Choose this qualification if you already have extensive experience of riding horses, ideally racehorses. You may already be employed in the racing industry and wish to progress to work riding, and learn how to improve racehorses' performance. You should be at least 16 years of age, and have an interest and experience in this area.

It will confirm your ability to:

- ride work on a variety of racehorses
- improve the performance of racehorses on the flat
- report effectively on horses' performance in relation to fitness, soundness, education and schooling requirements
- assess the optimum going and distance requirements for individual horses.



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
