- using horse rugs
- catching, leading and controlling a horse
- grooming
- basic equine nutrition
- health and safety.



1ST4SPORT LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA IN WORK BASED RACEHORSE CARE

This qualification will provide you with the skills and knowledge you need to work with thoroughbreds in the racing and breeding industries.
